Improve home/school communication	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Improved and updated website</li> <li>➤ Text messaging service to parents</li> <li>➤ Weekly newsletter introduced by new HT</li> <li>➤ Home/School planners introduced across the whole school for each child</li> </ul>
Improve home work/make more consistent across year groups	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Homework books introduced across the school</li> <li>➤ Homework across whole school now sent out on Thursday and due back on Tuesday (same for all year groups so helps with siblings etc)</li> <li>➤ English and Maths homework now sent weekly so more homework being done</li> <li>➤ Summer Home Learning packs sent home for all year groups</li> <li>➤ HT raised expectations re marking of homework and rewards for children</li> </ul>
Make behaviour rewards/sanctions consistent across whole school	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ New HT asked for parent input into new Behaviour Policy and Golden Time</li> <li>➤ All children now receive housepoint awards</li> </ul>
More parental information on assessment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Parental input into our new assessment system.</li> <li>➤ New HT has held Parent Workshops on levels</li> <li>➤ Parent Workshops held on Maths and Reading</li> <li>➤ Parent workshops now annually held re Phonics, Assessments, Maths, Spellings and Reading.</li> <li>➤ Parent Workshops on SATS for Y2 and Y6.</li> </ul>
Improve reading book system across whole school	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ KS1 books separated into books to read in school and books to read at home</li> <li>➤ Updates in home/school planners re reading with an adult in school/Guided Reading</li> <li>➤ Accelerated Reader introduced for KS2 children to pitch reading levels to books in library</li> </ul>
Improve information about child's progress	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Parents' Evenings now held earlier in the term and now in class (not all in one area so privacy improved)</li> <li>➤ Children's levels each half term are now in the back of their planners</li> <li>➤ Children's progress now tracked half termly</li> </ul>

Improve access to the school playground in the morning and avoid bottle necks at end of day	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ School green gates opened slightly later</li> <li>➤ Markers put on playground for KS1 children to line up which also means KS2 children can get round to KS2 playground more safely</li> <li>➤ Parents requested via newsletter to not wait by the gate with buggies-this has also improved.</li> </ul>
Improve quality of school meals	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ From September 2016, we now have a new catering company and school meals are now cooked on school site daily. Hot meals uptake up by 75%.</li> </ul>
More selection of after school clubs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ As well as range of sports, we have now offered Music, Drama, French, Young Voices, Cooking and Cheerleading.</li> </ul>
Raise public profile of the school within the community	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Gained parental input into our website design and also our new promotional marketing leaflet.</li> </ul>
Improve parking outside of the school	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ With Parish Council support, had yellow lines repainted outside of school and we now have coned off the cul-de-sac at pick up and drop off times of the day.</li> </ul>
Have a better idea of what the school day is like for their child	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Every year children now have a copy of their weekly timetable to send home.</li> </ul>
